Dear parents,

As we reach the final few weeks of term, we would now like to allow students a little more flexibility and independence in how they use their study time. We would therefore like all students to continue attending College for periods 1 and 2 and tutor time each day, but are happy for them to leave the college site and work from home or in the university library (should they wish to) when they have no more lessons. Therefore if a student has a lesson period 5, we would expect them to stay with us all day, but if they have no more lessons after period 3 they are allowed to leave the site.

If any member of staff feels that a student is not completely up to date with their work, or that their work is not at an acceptable level, then this privilege will obviously be taken away. We would still expect students to use this time for studying, and as such students should be prepared that they could still be asked to stay in college if requested so should not arrange for work shifts during the college day.

It is a student's responsibility to be aware of their timetable and the current week, as part of the school two week timetable. It is not acceptable for students to justify truanting lessons due to confusion over the school week or their timetabled classes. Should this occur then home study will be taken from the individual involved and they will be expected to be in school for the entire day.

It is critical that students sign in and out of college at all times in reception so we always have a full record of who is and is not on site. This has been made very clear to all students.
